

RULE 8. AUDITORS AND MASTERS

8.1 NOTICE OF HEARINGS

Rule 8.1(1) Notice.

Auditors and masters shall give at least ten (10) days notice of hearings held by them to all parties interested or to their attorneys of record in the manner provided in Pa. O.C.R. 5.1. Notice of succeeding hearings given by the auditor or master at a hearing of which proper notice had been given shall constitute sufficient notice of each such succeeding hearing.

8.6 NOTICE OF FILING OF REPORT

Rule 8.6(1) Notice and Objections.

An auditor or master shall give notice of the filing of his report to all parties of record or to their counsel of record. Any party in interest shall have the right to file Objections to such report within thirty (30) days after the date of filing or the date of notice, whichever occurs later. If any Objection is filed, the matter shall be set for argument in the manner provided in Monroe Co. O.C.R. 1.2(3).

8.7 CONFIRMATION OF REPORT

Rule 8.7(1) Decree.

If no Objection is filed within the period provided in Monroe Co. O.C.R. 8.6(1), the Court may enter a decree confirming the auditor's report or adopting the master's report.
